Family Night: Treasure Hunt

We are going to hunt treasures of God's promises. Make it applicable to your family's needs.

Preparation:

1. Write down the needs of your family members.
2. Think where you are going to hide the treasure and write down the clue underneath the need.
3. Place it folded in a bottle/container.
4. Find the Scripture promises of God to those needs. Write it on a card.
5. Hide the treasure cards.
6. Pray over the evening (privately) that everyone will get the promise they need for the moment.
7. Have some praise music.
8. Have something to celebrate with like your family's favorite cake or you can end the evening with Breaking of Bread – crowning and declaring Jesus, King and Lord of your home.

This treasure hunt works like this:

1. You play from a central point. Everybody comes together, praise music playing.
2. One pulls out a paper with the need and clue, reads it and goes to search for it. (You can do it either one by one or everybody gets a clue and runs simultaneously to get the treasure.)
3. When the treasure is found you come back to the central point and share the need and the promise with the family. Carry on until all the treasures have been found.
4. Celebrate and/or have Breaking of Bread.

Example:

Salvation	We enter our house there	Matthew 18:11, John 6:14
Assurance of salvation	In front of the book on my beside table	John 1:12, 1 John 5:12
Forgiveness	Where we clean ourselves daily	1 John 1:9
Healing	Where sleeps, when she is not well	Jeremiah 30:17(a), 1 Peter 2:24
Guidance	(Underneath a torch/candle)	Psalm 32:8
Finances for needs	(In your purse)	Matthew 6:31-34
Freedom from fear	Somewhere in daddy and mommy's bedroom	Psalm 34:4
