### COMMUNITY: PORTRAYING JESUS

#### A Portrait of God, Our Father

---



#### Kick off with The Mirror Game:

- Let the family pair up in two's and stand facing one another about a meter apart.
- One is the leader and do or say something, the partner is the mirror –imitating the leader exactly (e.g. stand on right leg, sing a song, etc.).
- Play music.
- Partners change roles after a few minutes – the leader become the mirror and the mirror is now the leader.



We learned that Jesus is our example of how to do life together as a family and a community.

Jesus said in John 5:19 of Himself He does only what He sees the Father doing. *“Whatever the Father does, the Son does also.”* (NLT)

So when Jesus valued the Samaritan women as precious, had compassion on her and extended grace to her, He followed the example of His Father, our Father in heaven.

Let us read, listen and discover in Psalm 103 what God, our Father, does, His compassion grace and how much value people has in His eyes.

Ask Holy Spirit to teach you.

Parents, you do this in different ways depending on your children's ages. Involve everyone. Remember, participation is important in learning. For example:

Read the Psalm in portions – v.1-2, 3-5, 6-7, 8-10, etc.

After each portion stop and questions like:

- What stands out for you in these verses?
- What is Father God doing here?
- What does David say about God?
- Is God merciful?
- Does He has compassion and love in His heart?)



### Discuss and share:

- Share how you experienced God's goodness, love, mercy and grace recently.
- Did you experience love and grace in our home? Did you feel valued? When? Share these special moments.
- Is there anyone you know that needs to experience God's love, goodness and grace? How can we reach out to him/her? What can we do?



### Prayer:

- Have a time of praise and thanksgiving – praising God for His love and grace you experienced.
- Pray for the person(s) in need you are going to reach out to.
- Pray for our nation – a true turning back to God in spirit and in truth.



### Memory Verse:

Don't forget our Memory Verse! Keep on filling your heart and mind with the Word of God.

Psalm 103:8: *"The Lord is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, abounding in love."*
