I am pretty sure that most of us experiencing some pruning in our lives during this time and season. I am not a gardener and I prune to the best of my knowledge, but often with uncertainty in my heart whether I do it the right way. How wonderful to have the assurance that the One who is pruning us, is our loving Father, the perfect One, with perfect knowledge, knowing exactly what and how - the best way for the best results.
