“And in the last days it shall be, God declares, that I will pour out my Spirit on all flesh, and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams;” Acts 2:17

When the Holy Spirit was ‘poured out’ from heaven, He filled Jesus’ followers who were waiting and praying in the upper room, as Jesus had instructed them to do. Suddenly the supernatural of God broke into their lives. They became bold and people thought they were drunk. But they were motivated and directed by God, the Holy Spirit.

Peter explained their behaviour, referring to a prophecy from hundreds of years before given by Joel, an Old Testament prophet. Dreams, visions and prophecy is the language of the Spirit and part of the signs and wonders that should turn people to Jesus. The Spirit always glorifies Jesus. The goal is that people should “call on His name” for salvation.

“And it shall come to pass that everyone who calls upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.” Acts 2:21

Share of His grace, share of His goodness, speak about how He rescued you from sin and your past and tell others the messages He gives you for them through dreams, visions and prophecy. Let’s be open channels for our beloved Lord and share Jesus with others.
