Paul's heart for God's people

Text: Colossians 1:24-2:6 NKJV

Col 1:29 "Whereunto I also labour, striving according to his working, which worketh in me mightily."

Three key aspects in Paul's letter we are focusing on:

v. Through our relationship with God in Christ.

- 1) Understanding who Christ is,
- 2) Understanding who we are in Him,
- 3) Walking out our faith journey with Christ.

When we do that, I believe this will help us understand Paul's heart for God's people, a clear picture of **"Christ in Us"**.

²⁴I now rejoice in my sufferings for you, and fill up in my flesh what is lacking in the afflictions of Christ, for the sake of His body, which is the church, ²⁵ of which I became a minister according to the stewardship from God which was given to me for you, to fulfil the word of God, ²⁶ the mystery which has been hidden from ages and from generations, but now has been revealed to His saints. ²⁷ To them God willed to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: **which is Christ in you, the hope of glory**. ²⁸ Him we preach, warning every man and teaching every man in all wisdom, that we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus. ²⁹ To this end I also labour, striving according to His working which works in me mightily.

Not Philosophy but Christ

² For I want you to know what a great conflict I have for you and those in Laodicea, and for as many as have not seen my face in the flesh, ² that their hearts may be encouraged, being knit together in love, and attaining to all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the knowledge of the mystery of God, both of the Father and of Christ, ³ in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.

1. Understanding who Christ is

He was supreme in the beginning and—leading the resurrection parade—he is supreme in the end. From beginning to end he is there, towering far above everything, everyone. So spacious is he, so expansive, that everything of God finds its proper place in him without crowding. Not only that, but all the broken and dislocated pieces of the universe—people and things, animals, and atoms—get properly fixed and fit together in vibrant harmonies, all because of his death, his blood that poured down from the cross.

Col 1:18-20 MSG

Jesus declares in **Luke 4:18-19** NKJV "The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, Because He has anointed Me To preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives And recovery of sight to the blind, To set at liberty those who are oppressed; To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord."

Liberty in our health, finances, relationships and every area of our lives.
We now live in a time when all our debts to God have been cancelled and all the things the devil stole from us have been returned.
Liberty leads to a transformed life.
Every good work that Jesus did amongst the people was motivated by His heart of compassion .
His mandate to see them set free from the sickness and yoke of bondage the devil had placed over them.

		Acts 10:38 AMPC , "How God anointed and consecrated Jesus of Nazareth with the [Holy] Spirit and with strength and ability and power; how He went about doing good and, in particular, curing all who were harassed and oppressed by [the power of] the devil, for God was with Him."
		After triumphing and making a show of the enemy Jesus told His disciples to do the same. This is the same message that Paul relayed to the Colossians and applies to us today.
		We also have been given the authority and mandate to use His Name and operate by that power to enforce the devil's defeat wherever we go! (Matthew 28:18-20; Mark 16:17-18).

		How is it possible for us to carry out this mandate? Jesus said these signs of authority accompany those who believe that Jesus is the Son of God!
		We have become one with Him (1 Cor 6:17) . The fact is from that moment, we are all anointed to become His feet, eyes and hands to fulfill his plan and purpose.
		The truth is we, have been set free, from all our sins —past, present, and even future—are already forgiven. As a result of the indwelling Holy Spirit, we have that same anointing and power within us!
		Jesus is the light of the world, now because He is in us we also become the light. We should let our light shine in the darkest places and not shun dark places as is the natural tendency of believers.
		We are the salt of the world (3 characteristics of salt, it heals (restore & reconcile), gives flavour and preserves) .
		This is our new DNA through Christ, Jesus now works through us to restore, reconcile and preserve life. (Joseph to his brothers, "God sent me ahead of you to preserve life").
		We should not second guess who we are, when we know who we are, we know what To do.
		We are salt and light, His feet, eyes and mouth, His temple, His vessels. We are overcomers because he who is in us has overcome the world.
		When you believe in Christ you are born into Christ. Family if we can believe this our lives will be radically transformed.

In contrast, the New Testament believer has now had these mysteries made "manifest." Sad to say, most Christians have not conceived this either. Hence Paul's letter.

Step 1: Renewing our minds to this truth

Step 2: Having faith in the finished work of the cross.

Step 1: Mind Renewal ☐ We are already complete in Him but we need to become manifested sons of God by being renewed in the spirit of our minds by the word of God. (Ephesians 4:24) ☐ Mind renewal is not cramming scriptures but a change of mind and seeing who God is, and who we are in Christ. We are righteous, holy and above reproach. Let us see ourselves that way. ☐ **Example:** Only David looked at Goliath differently but the whole army of the Israelites were required to know / cram up the Tora (Genesis, Exodus, Levi, Numbers & Duet). Hebrews 4:2 ☐ When we train ourselves to be in the habit of meditating on the scriptures that reminds us of our new life in Christ Jesus, the flow of faith from inside our spirit-man will begin to dominate our thoughts and words. As we speak these truths, from the conviction of our hearts - we will walk in the reality of them! When we align our thoughts with the truth of God's Word, our spiritman will dominate over the flesh nature. ☐ Seeing things the way God says they are – If the Word says it, it is so! i. Let's choose to see God for who He is. ii. Seeing ourselves as God sees us. God is a Spirit and sees us through our new, born-again spirits. iii. Let's choose to see life as the Word reveals it. ☐ If God says I am, I am. I am healed. I am blessed. I am redeemed. I am righteous. I am wise. I am set apart. I am a citizen of heaven. I am more than a conqueror. I am victorious. I am not ashamed. I can do all things through Christ. I am loved. I am accepted. I am seated with Christ in heavenly places. I am a child of His love. I am forgiven. I have the mind of Christ, and I hear Him. I am at peace with God. I am Step 2: Put Faith in the finished work of the cross - the blood of Jesus ☐ Romans 3:25 says we are made right with God when we believe in the blood of Jesus, and what it has accomplished for us! In other words - we are to have faith in the power of the blood of Jesus Christ! ☐ Sin had to be dealt with, and it was dealt with, through the blood of the Lord Jesus Christ. We are now holy, blameless, and unreproveable in His sight. Ushering Christ to be able to live in us, we are above reproach in His sight. Col 1: 22. ☐ No amount of effort, human works, or mankind's own righteousness could bring this to pass. We were re-born into victory, born into authority, born into wealth, born into health, born into righteousness, born into wisdom, born into the new covenant, born into the family of God.

		The communication of our faith becomes effective by us acknowledging the good thing already in us in Christ (Christ in us) - Philemon 1:6
		So that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, (Ephesians 3:17)
3.	W	alking out our faith journey with Christ.
		Col 2:2 That their hearts might be comforted, being knit together in love, and unto all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the acknowledgement of the mystery of God, and of the Father, and of Christ.
		Full assurance of understanding - To make certain, to pursue constantly. To know thoroughly. To perceive and comprehend.
		Acknowledge means - Act of admitting and recognition of another existence. It is already a reality that every believer is indwelt by the Spirit of Christ
		We need to keep pressing toward the mark (Philippians 3:14) until we receive the highest level of acknowledgment, understanding, and assurance possible
		Within every born again person is a new creation waiting to be released (2 Cor 5:17). All it takes is someone who believes.
Be	ing	knit together by love : Faith works by love
		"Faith works hand in hand with love. God gave His son by love, and it is through putting faith in this truth that we receive our salvation.
		As believers in Jesus, we are part of a body, and there are some things that only function properly when we come together as a body in love.
		"True saving faith is more than a conviction of the mind. It transforms the heart to love"
		Quote from John Wesley
		True Christianity is to 'have the mind of Christ,' which is demonstrated in love for God and neighbour. The real freedom of the Christian is not just the freedom from guilt or release from the pangs of hell but the freedom to love with the love of God Himself shed abroad in our hearts by the indwelling Holy Spirit. Freedom as 'nothing higher and nothing lower than thislove governing the heart and life,

Being knit together by love: God dwells in us by love. – 1 John 4:7-17

through all our tempers, words, and actions"

"7Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God. 13 This is how we know that we live in him and he in us: He has given us of his Spirit. 14 And we have seen and testify that the Father has sent his Son to be the Savior of the world. 15 If anyone acknowledges that Jesus is the Son of God, God lives in them and they in God. 16 And so we know and rely on the love God has for us. God is love. Whoever lives in love lives in God, and God in them. 17 This is how love is made complete among us so that we will have confidence on the day of judgment: In this world we are like Jesus. 18 There is no fear in love. But perfect love drives out fear because fear has to do with punishment. The one who fears is not made perfect in love.

Wisdom to walk out our faith journey

Col 2:3 In whom are hid all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.		
Col 2:	4 And this I say, lest any man should beguile you with enticing words.	
	Since we are in Him (2 Corinthians 5:17) and He is in us (Christ in us), all the "wisdom and knowledge" of God is in us.	
	This wisdom is in our born-again spirits. It does not have to just stay there. We can draw it out. We can draw on that wisdom as we abide in Christ.	
	We need to be grounded in the foundational principles of the Gospel so that no one could move us as well.	
	Once we get the revelation that Christ is in us in His fullness and that we are complete in Him, how can we ever move away from this truth? To what can it compare?	
Call to	action : Lets do an inventory of who Christ is in us .	
Col 2:	6 As ye have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk ye in him:	
	Examine yourselves to see whether you are in the faith; test yourselves. Do you not realize that Christ Jesus is in you—unless, of course, you fail the test? Walk and act like it, produce fruit like it. (2 Corinthians 12:5).	
	To walk in the truth of Christ in us and being an overcomer and authority starts with believing Jesus is the Son of God. The word says in 1 John 5:5 - who is he who overcomes the world but he who believes that Jesus is the son of God.	
	And when you believe you acknowledge your need for a saviour, and you are willingly to be on journey with Christ.	
	If you shall believe, confess with your mouth that Jesus is the Son of God, then you shall be saved and when the Son sets you free, you are free indeed. Romans 10:11.

	What happened when we believed on Christ? We were created new, destined to succeed, and received an inheritance in the family of God!
